### Greetings from Mooroolbark Community Garden

#### From the Garden Gate:

It has been a busy month down in the garden, with the heat keeping us on our toes to ensure the plants got plenty to drink, to preparing for our first monthly Market! But more on that later.....

You will have noticed the last of the summer veg being removed, cutting it at the base and then composting. Why cut and not pull out? Leaving the root systems behind as you clear the beds helps to improve the soil structure, the biodiversity in the soil and gives the worms and other microbes something to eat which in turn improves the soil.

We have been planting our next season crops of brussels sprouts, cabbage, broccoli, etc plus we have planted out garlic, both soft neck and hard neck, which we are going to have harvesting classes on it October/November, watch this space for more details.
